Simplified loading/unloading for motorcoaches visiting Historic Philadelphia with overnight parking available!

Loading and Unloading

Tour operators who transport their groups by motorcoach now have an easy and efficient way to drop off and pick up groups visiting Philadelphia's Independence National Historical Park – the new **Independence Transportation Center (ITC)**. The ITC has 11 spots for loading and unloading, with an additional three spots around the corner on Race Street. Located adjacent to the new National Constitution Center, the ITC sits in the heart of the historic district and is in close proximity to the Independence Visitor Center, the new Liberty Bell Center and Independence Hall, as well as other sites, attractions, restaurants and shops in Philadelphia's historic district.

Drop-off and Pick up

In addition to the new ITC, **five drop-off and pick-up locations are provided** throughout the historic district for motorcoach groups. These are:

- East side of Third Street, between Walnut and Chestnut streets (in front of the former INHP Visitors Center);
- In front of Christ Church on Second Street, between Arch and Market streets;
- In front of the Betsy Ross House on Arch Street, between Second and Third streets;
- In front of City Tavern, just north of Second and Walnut streets; and,
- Fifth Street, between Ranstead and Chestnut streets, for seniors and handicapped visitors only.

Motorcoach Parking

A designated motorcoach parking facility nearby provides a secure, convenient and comfortable location for motorcoach drivers to wait while their groups explore the area and take in all the delights of the city. The driver can park in one of 40 secured spaces and enjoy an air-conditioned waiting area that features bathrooms and showers, televisions, sleeping lounges and vending machines. The driver will also receive coupons for local restaurants and family entertainment venues.

Directions

Drivers can access the ITC from Race Street, between Fifth and Sixth streets. After dropping off, the drivers can proceed to the new designated parking facility on Callowhill Street, between Front and Second streets.

Fees and Hours of Operation

- \$20 per motorcoach for the day (payable at the ITC or the parking facility).
Driver must display the parking permit they received with payment.
- Overnight parking will be an additional \$10 (for a total fee of \$30). Reservations for overnight parking should be made before 5:00 p.m. by calling 215-925-3706.
- The parking area is open from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., seven days a week.

Please note that the ITC and the five designated sites are the only areas where groups can be dropped off and picked up. Parking and idling regulations will be strictly enforced.
