*Oldest scholarly society in the U.S.*
- 10 Library Hall**  
*The nation's first public library and the former Library of Congress*
- 11 Second Bank of the United States**  
*Once the most influential financial institutions in the world, now a portrait gallery*
- 12 Carpenters' Hall**  
*The birthplace of the American identity*
- 13 New Hall Military Museum**  
*Interpreting the role of the military in early U.S. history*
- 14 The First Bank of the United States**  
*Sparked the first great Constitutional debate*
- 15 Franklin Court & B. Free Franklin Post Office**  
*Benjamin Franklin's home and the only Colonial themed Post Office*
- 16 Christ Church**  
*An active parish since 1695, often called the "Nation's Church"*
- 17 Betsy Ross House**  
*Where Betsy Ross sewed the first Stars and Stripes*
- 18 Arch Street Friends Meeting House**  
*Home to the Society of Friends*
- 19 Christ Church Burial Ground**  
*The final resting place of Benjamin Franklin*
- 20 National Constitution Center**  
*Exercise your right to explore the Constitution of the U.S.*
