**Philadelphia, Pennsylvania** - June 7, 2005 – Celebrate the July 4<sup>th</sup> weekend with The Constitutional Walking Tour of Philadelphia. Visitors to Philadelphia will be able to follow in the Founding Fathers' footsteps with The Constitutional Guided Walking Tour, an escorted journey through America's most historic square mile. - Costs \$15.00 per adult, \$12.50 per child, ages 3-12. (Group rates are available on parties of 25 or more for conventions, special events, camps and schools, and custom private tours for parties of 2 or more are also available upon request.)
